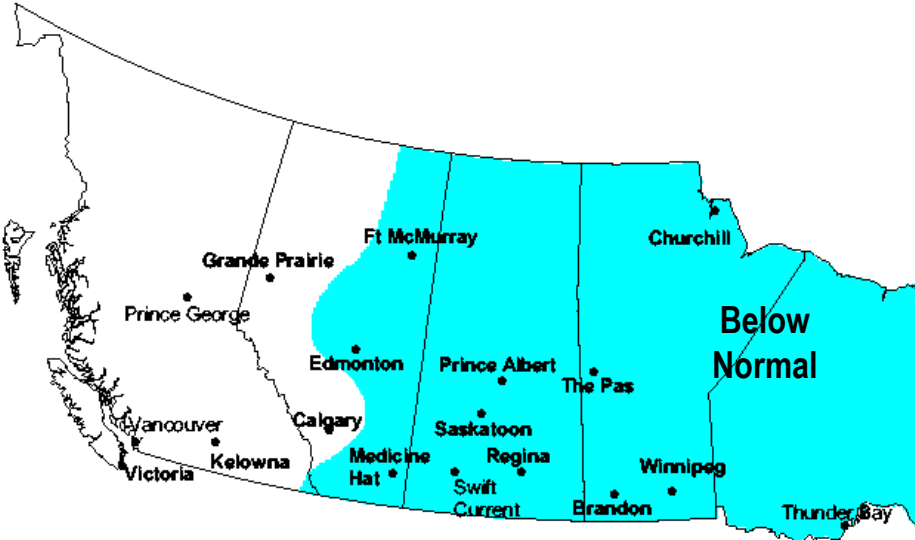
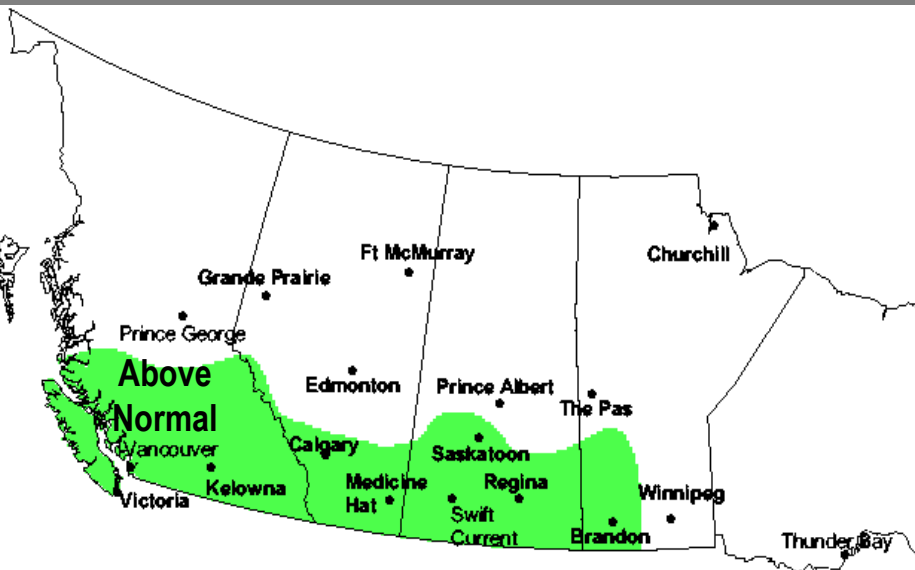

Precipitation



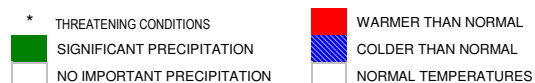
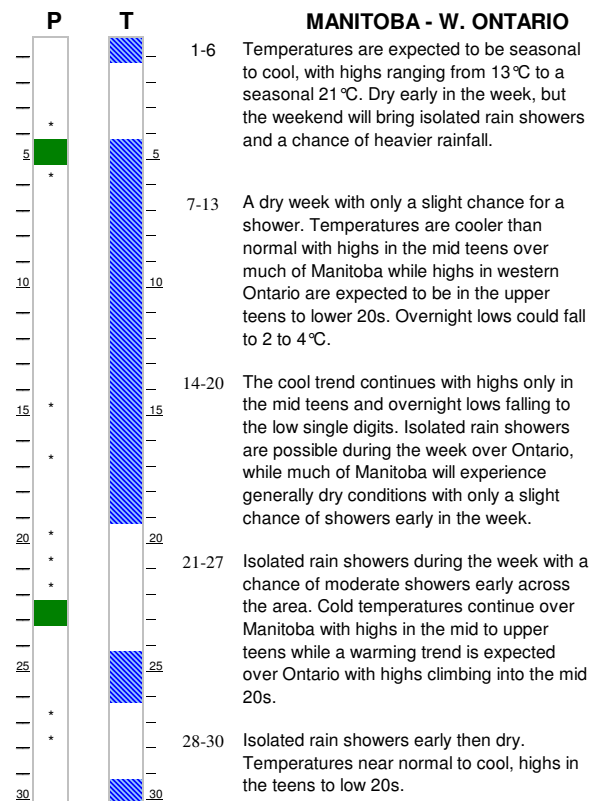
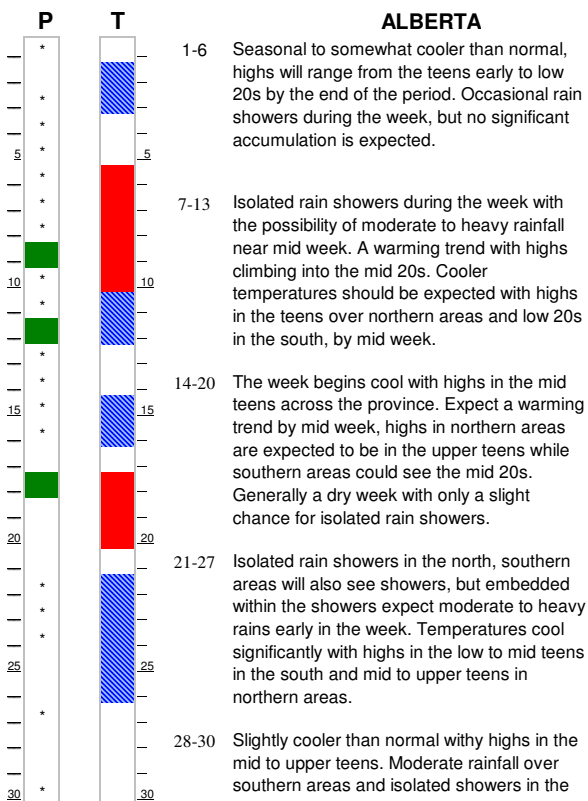
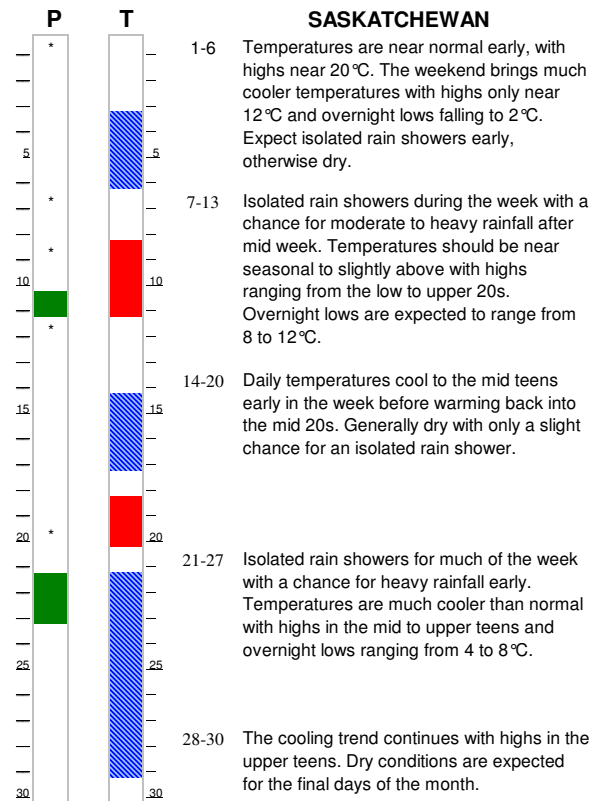
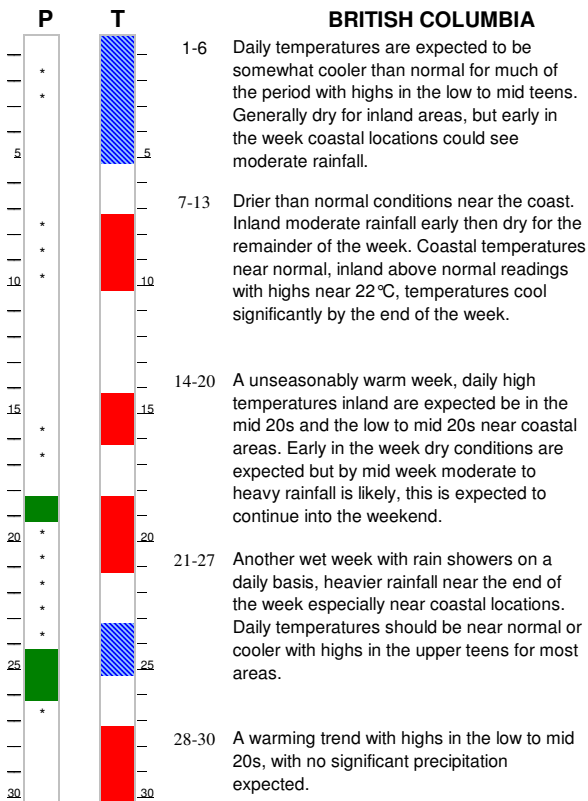

Monthly Climatic Outlook

British Columbia will be the only province with temperatures near normal, all other locations should look for the month to average 1 to 2°C cooler than normal. Above normal rainfall is expected across the southern areas of the western provinces while Ontario and the northern areas of British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba should expect seasonal levels of precipitation.
